CMC-Steele Creek

CMC-Steele Creek is the first healthcare pavilion in our region. This innovative facility and its unique service offerings give everyone in our community access to a higher level of patient-focused care.

Q. What is a healthcare pavilion and what kind of services does it provide?

A. As a healthcare pavilion, CMC-Steele Creek is an innovative outpatient facility designed to give local residents fast and convenient access to healthcare services.

- 24-hour emergency department
- Physicians board certified in emergency medicine
- Charlotte Pediatric Clinic, Mecklenburg Medical Group (internal medicine) and Piedmont GYN/OB
- Advanced diagnostic imaging, including a 64-slice CT scanner, ultrasound and X-ray
- Comprehensive laboratory services and a retail pharmacy

Q. Why a healthcare pavilion?

A. Studies have shown that most people who come to a hospital don't need to be admitted overnight. Instead, they typically require emergency outpatient treatment or a scheduled outpatient procedure. A healthcare pavilion like CMC-Steele Creek can bring these in-demand healthcare services to a community in a more intimate setting while also costing far less to build than a typical hospital.

Q. Why was CMC-Steele Creek built in this community?

A. Prior to the arrival of CMC-Steele Creek, more than 50 percent of the people in the community lived at least 30 minutes away from the closest emergency department. CMC-Steele Creek was strategically placed to meet the growing healthcare needs of this region.

Q. What type of emergencies can CMC-Steele Creek handle?

A. CMC-Steele Creek is not a hospital or an urgent care center. However, CMC-Steele Creek offers a 24-hour emergency department with physicians board certified in emergency medicine that are standing by to treat emergency needs, including chest pain and heart attack, shortness of breath, stroke, head injuries and orthopaedic injuries. Patients who need hospitalization or are critically injured can also be transported via helicopter or ambulance to CMC-Pineville or to Carolinas Medical Center, the region's only Level I Trauma Center.

Q. In addition to emergency care, what other services does CMC-Steele Creek provide?

A. CMC-Steele Creek is designed to be a comprehensive healthcare resource, so if you or someone in your family isn't feeling well, we can help. Our medical office building includes physicians and specialists from Charlotte Pediatric Clinic, Mecklenburg Medical Group (internal medicine) and Piedmont GYN/OB. It also houses CMC Rx Pharmacy, a full-service retail pharmacy.

Q. Where is CMC-Steele Creek located?

A. CMC-Steele Creek is located at 13640 Steelecroft Parkway, near the corner of South Tryon Street (Highway 49) and Steele Creek Road (Highway 160) and near Rivergate Shopping Center.
